## Ser/Estar

+ I ----- AM  
 + You/We/They ----- ARE  
 + He/She/It ----- IS

- I ----- AM NOT  
 - You/We/They ----- ARE NOT/AREN'T  
 - He/She/It ----- IS NOT / ISN'T

? AM ----- I?  
 ? ARE ----- You/We/They?  
 ? IS ----- He/She/It ?

# HAVE GOT

## Tener

+ I/You/We/They ----- HAVE GOT  
 + He/She/It ----- HAS GOT

- I/You/We/They ----- HAVEN'T GOT  
 - He/She/It ----- HASN'T GOT

? HAVE --- I/ You/We/They --- GOT?  
 HAS ----- He/She/It ----- GOT?

\*We don't use HAVE GOT with age and feelings: I am 11 years old / He is tired
