ALTERNATIVAS**"SIMPLE PAST" TENSE:**

Use:

- To talk about **experiences** in the past.
- For finished actions, states or habits in the past.

Structure:

(+) Subject + **verb (past)** + complement.
(Regular / Irregular)

(-) Subject + **did + not + verb (base form)** + complement.
(didn't)

(?) Did + Subject + **verb (base form)** + complement + ?

(+)	I sent a letter. We traveled to Spain.
	did not= didn't
(-)	I did not send a letter. We didn't travel to Spain. Did you send a letter? Did We travel to Spain?
(?)	Answers: Yes, I/you/he/she/it/we/they did . No, I/you/he/she/it/we/they didn't .

Time Markers:

- Last (Last week, last month, last year, last Monday ...)
- Ago (six days ago, two hours ago, ten years ago ...)
- Yesterday (yesterday morning/afternoon/evening)
