

Treating Minor Burns

Have you ever encountered a situation where your skin (0) come into contact with a hot iron or where your hand got scalded by hot water as you were making a drink? These injuries are (9) call burns. You can also place the burned area in a container of cool (12) waters. However, you (13) must use ice as it will restrict blood flow which is bad.
