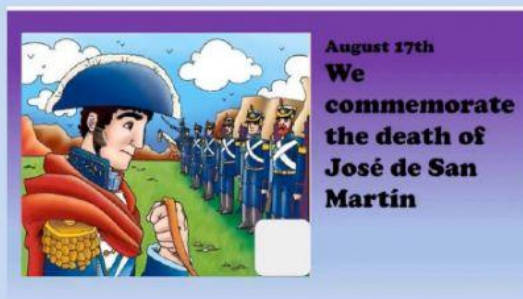


## JOSE DE SAN MARTIN , our NATIONAL HERO

| 1  | Where was he born?                                         |   | He was Argentine/Argentinian.                                                                              |
| 2  | When was he born?                                          |   | He <b>is</b> the Liberator of America, the FATHER of our COUNTRY. He <b>is</b> considered a National Hero. |
| 3  | Where did he die?                                          |   | He was born on February 25 <sup>th</sup> , 1778.                                                           |
| 4  | When did he die?                                           |   | He served as a military man. He was a sub-lieutenant, a lieutenant (teniente) and a captain.               |
| 5  | How old was he when he died?                               |   | His nickname is the Liberator of America.                                                                  |
| 6  | What was his nationality?<br>=<br>What nationality was he? | 1 | He was born in Yapeyú, Corrientes, Argentina.                                                              |
| 7  | Where was San Martin from?                                 |   | Yes, he <b>did</b> . His wife was Maria de los Remedios de Escalada y la Quintana.                         |
| 8  | <b>Did</b> he get married?                                 |   | Yes, they <b>did</b> . Her name was Maria de las Mercedes Tomasa de San Martin y Escalada. (Merceditas)    |
| 9  | <b>Did</b> they have any children?                         |   | He died in Boulogne-sur-Mer, France.                                                                       |
| 10 | What is his nickname?                                      |   | He was from Argentina.                                                                                     |
| 11 | <b>Did</b> he receive any merit, any award?                |   | He died on August 17 <sup>th</sup> , 1850.                                                                 |
| 12 | When did he first move to Spain?                           |   | He was in service from 1789 to 1822.                                                                       |
| 13 | What was his job/profession?                               |   | Yes, he was. He was named Captain in 1804.                                                                 |
| 14 | How did he cross The Andes?                                |   | They crossed The Andes during the period of January 19 <sup>th</sup> and February 13 <sup>th</sup> , 1817. |
| 15 | Where did he study?                                        |   | He was 72 years old.                                                                                       |

| 16 | <b>Was</b> he ever a Captain?                                |  | He and his family moved to Spain in 1783 when he was a child.                                                                                                                                                                            |
| 17 | What happened in <b>1813</b> ?                               |  | He crossed The Andes with 5,000 men, 10,000 mules and 1,500 horses.                                                                                                                                                                      |
| 18 | When did San Martin and the army (ejército) cross the Andes? |  | Yes, he did!<br>He participated in a lot of battles!!<br>In Europe and in America.                                                                                                                                                       |
| 19 | How long did the Crossing of the Andes last?                 |  | He studied in Europe.                                                                                                                                                                                                                    |
| 20 | What <b>is</b> he famous for?                                |  | He was awarded a GOLD medal for his actions during battle and raised to lieutenant colonel, among other things.                                                                                                                          |
| 21 | Did he participate in any battle?                            |  | The crossing took 21 days.                                                                                                                                                                                                               |
| 22 | How long was San Martin in service?                          |  | San Martin and the Army fought in San Lorenzo Battle; Argentina, on February 3rd, 1813.<br>RESULT: United Provinces Victory.<br>San Martin fell from the horse and was nearly killed, but Juan Bautista Cabral intervened and saved him. |
