Was he a hippie?

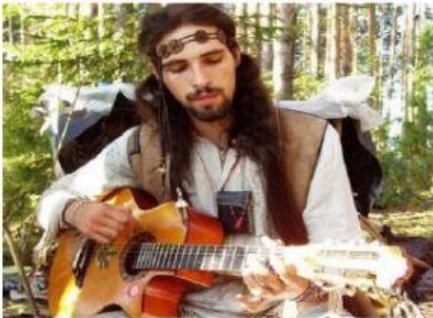
