












"What a good **book**," said Musa.

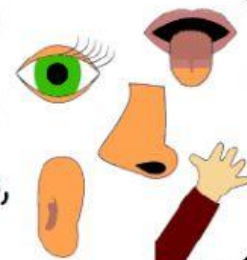
