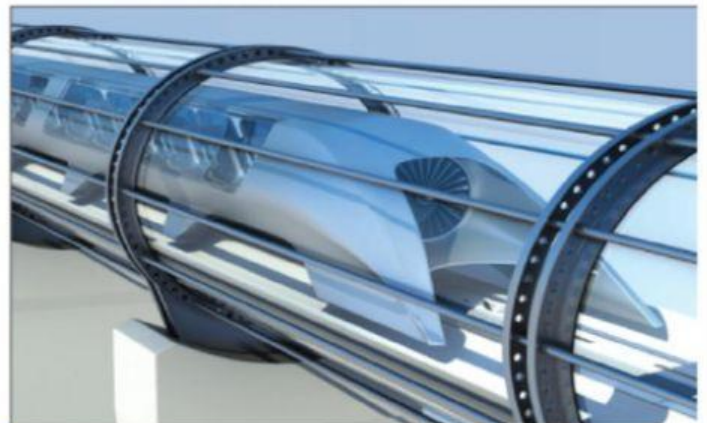

Los Angeles and San Francisco are cities in the state of California, in the U.S. They are about 650 kilometers **apart**. Millions of people travel between these cities every year. Today, the fastest way to travel between them is by airplane. It is about one hour. However, a new idea could make this trip shorter.

The Hyperloop is a kind of train. It could make the 650-kilometer trip in only thirty minutes. It could go 1,100 kilometers per hour, which is faster than an airplane. It would carry **passengers** in cars called pods. Pods would use **magnets** and low air **pressure** to **float** and move through **tubes**. This is how the Hyperloop would be able to go 650 kilometers in only thirty minutes.

The Hyperloop is still just an idea. It's the idea of an **inventor** named Elon Musk. It would cost **billions** of dollars, but it would save many people a lot of time.
