IF CONDITION, + RESULT


PRESENT SIMPLE + PRESENT SIMPLE

**If you leave ice in the sun, it melts.**

IF CONDITION RESULT



Zero conditionals are used for facts that are generally true and do not change. It refers to a general situation that always happens if a condition is met.



CONDITION RESULT

IF CLAUSE, + MAIN CLAUSE

**If you stand in the rain, you get wet.**

RESULT CONDITION

MAIN CLAUSE + IF CLAUSE

**You get wet if you stand in the rain.**

← COMMA IS NECESSARY

← NO COMMA
