'Much' is with used uncountable nouns and many is used with countable nouns.

Eg: How many students are there in the room? There isn't much space to move around. There are too many tables and chairs.

'A lot of' is used with both countable and uncountable nouns for affirmatives, negatives and questions.

Eg: We play a lot of games in the workshop. (Affirmative - countable) Eg: We also do a lot of thinking. (Afirmative - uncountable) Eg: Did you spend a lot of money at the bazaar? (Question)
