video script

(In the office, Mr. Rashid describes a recent vacation to Marie.)

Mr. Rashid: No. It (is / was) too salty for me,
and the waiters (are / were) very unfriendly.

Marie : (Do / Did) you go shopping at all?

Mr. Rashid: A little bit - until someone (steal / stole) my wallet.

Marie : (Is / Was) the flight home OK?

Mr. Rashid: Actually, they (cancel / canceled) my flight.
