I have a **sister** **who** is younger than me.

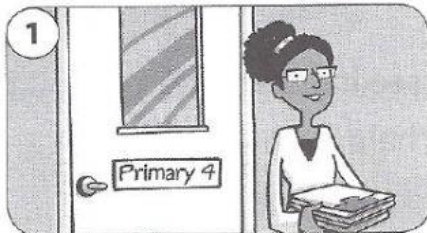
We jumped on the **bus**. The **bus** was going to Flores

Which is used for **animals** or **things**.

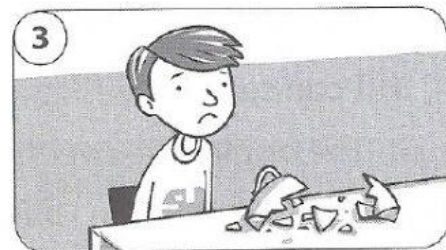

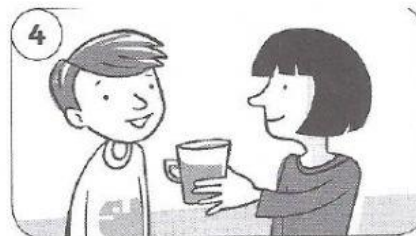

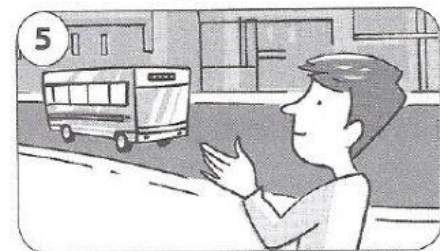
