


# Titanic

## 2.- FACTS AND FIGURES ABOUT THE TITANIC.

1. The *Titanic* sank at 2:20 a.m. on **15<sup>th</sup> April 1912**.
2. The ship was **882** feet long (approximately the length of three football fields) and **92.5** feet wide. It dropped more than **2.5** miles to the ocean floor.
3. There were only **16** lifeboats on board, instead of the **64** lifeboats of the original design.
4. When the *Titanic* sank, there were approximately **2,222** people on board (included passengers and crew), and only **705** survived.
