

A Little / A lot

We use A LITTLE and A LOT before nouns that **we can't count**.

- **A little** is used to describe a **SMALL** amount of something: There is **a little** cheese.
- **A lot of** is used to describe a **LARGE** amount of something: There is **a lot of** bread.
