Paragraph 1

Local people call Mongolia, a big country in Central Asia, the 'Land of the Blue Sky'. It has 260 sunny days a year. The largest city, Ulaanbaatar, is the coldest capital in the world. Mongolia has four seasons but these seasons are very different, and it is possible to experience four seasons in one day. Mongolia is very far inland, so the sea does not change its weather.

Paragraph 2

Spring is from March to mid-May. There can be snow, with periods of wind and sun. Sometimes it is so windy it makes the weather seem colder than it really is. Most of the rain falls in the northern area of the country.

Paragraph 3

Summer is from mid-May until late August, but it can still snow in the north of the country in the month of May. June weather is good and usually dry in all of the central and southern regions. The areas in the north and the mountains are sometimes cold. Temperatures in the desert can be up to 40 degrees centigrade.

Paragraph 4

Autumn is from late August until the end of October. There is often heavy rain in the north and central areas. The rivers become very full and the grass becomes very green in the south, and there are also many different colours in the forests of the north. The weather at this time of year can change at any minute. One minute you only need a T-shirt and the next minute you need a warm coat.

Paragraph 5

Winter is from November to February. There are many snow storms and the wind is freezing cold. The temperature sometimes falls to as much as minus 40 degrees centigrade. These winters are long. Life can be difficult, but it's an interesting time to visit Mongolia to experience something different.

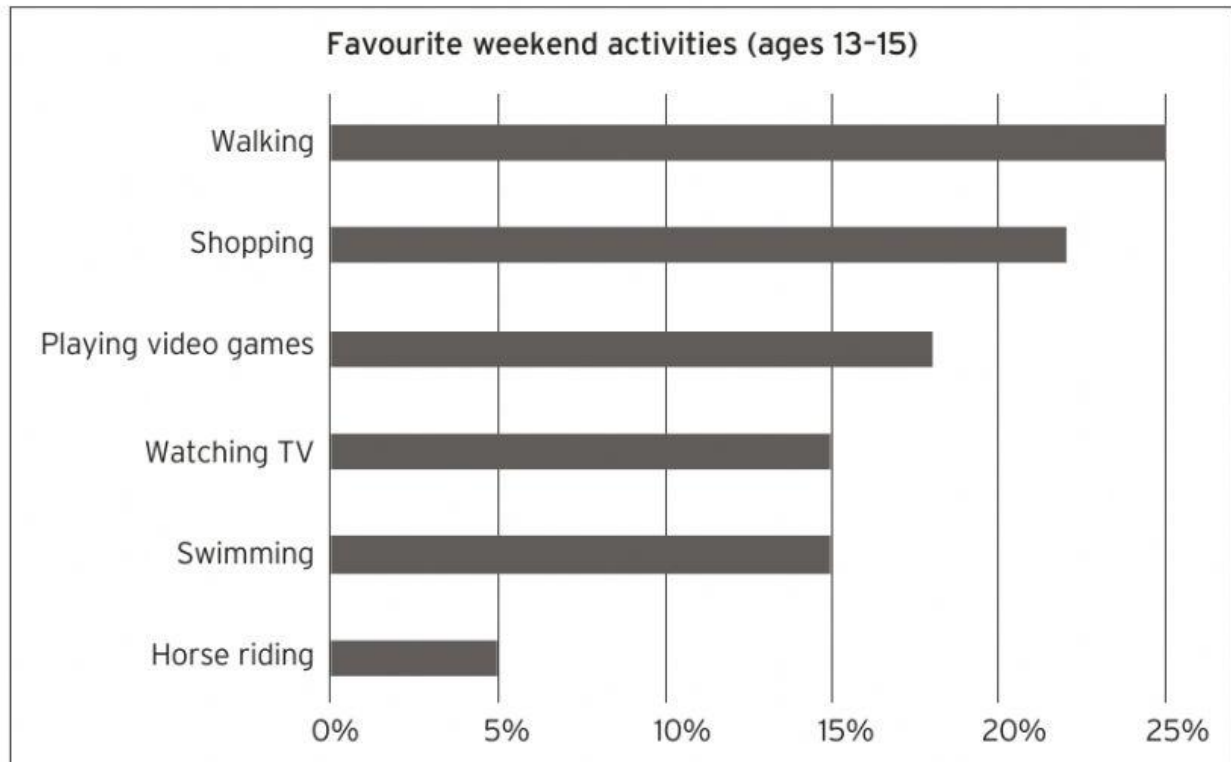
