4. Answer the questions

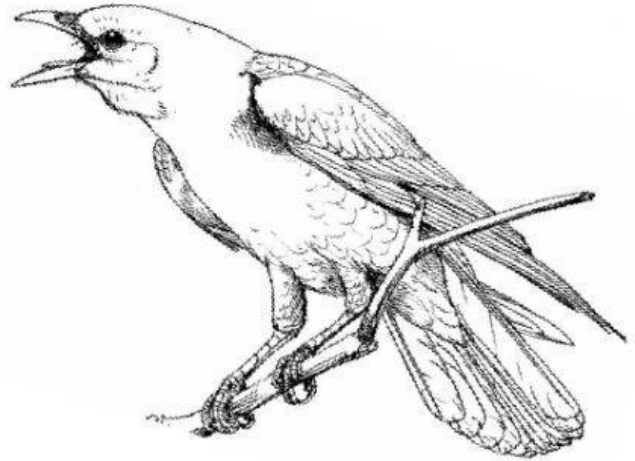
Why is the man reading his book?
