REMEMBER

Affirmative (+) – Câu khẳng định:

Most verbs (hầu hết động từ)	<u>Verb-Y</u> (động từ tận cùng -y)	<u>Verb-E</u> (động từ tận cùng -e)	Double consonants (nhân đôi phụ âm cuối – cấu trúc CVC)
paint - <u>painted</u>	try - <u>tried</u>	dance – <u>danced</u>	stop – <u>stopped</u>
cook - <u>cooked</u>	cry - <u>cried</u>	like – <u>liked</u>	plan - <u>planned</u>
watch - <u>watched</u>	BUT	agree - <u>agreed</u>	
	play – <u>played</u>		

Negative (-) – Câu phủ định:

I didn't study

We didn't study

You didn't study

They didn't study

He / She / It didn't study

Question (?) – Câu hỏi

Did you study? – Yes, I did. / No, I didn't.

Did he / she / it study? – Yes, he / she / it did. / No he / she / it didn't.

Did they study? – Yes, they did. / No, they didn't.

Time expressions – Các cụm từ chỉ thời gian:

last (last week, last Monday); **ago** (2 years ago); **yesterday**; **in 1997...**
