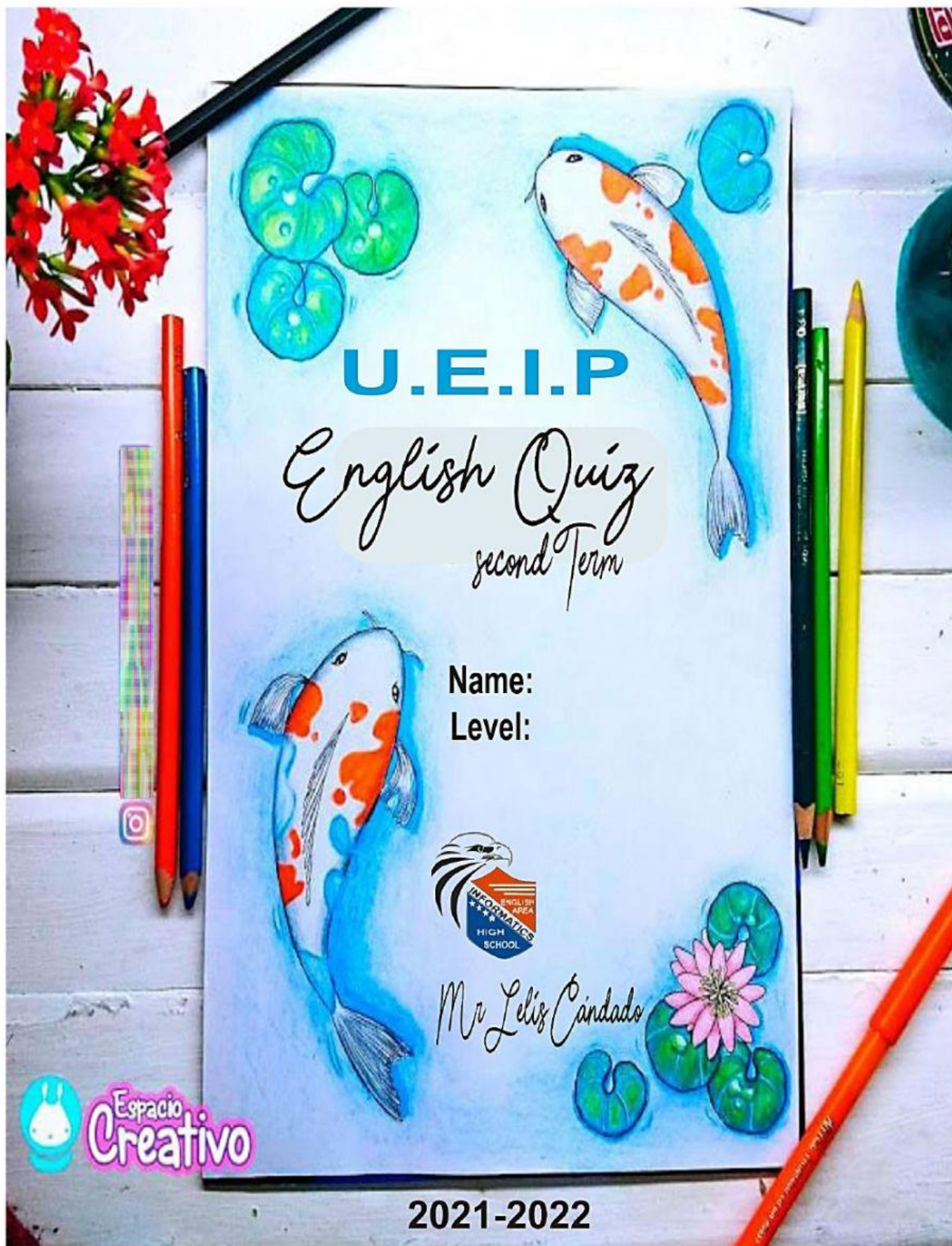

2 Read and answer the questions.

Many of us only talk or dream of visiting other countries. But members of the Travelers' Century Club have visited hundreds of countries! This exclusive club was founded in 1954, in Los Angeles, California. The founder wanted to give travelers a place to tell their stories and share their experiences. In those days, leisure travel was not very common. Few people could travel abroad, and even fewer could visit more than two or three countries. In 1960, the club had only 43 members; today it has over 2,000.

What are the qualifications to join? Only one: Members must have visited 100 or more countries or territories that are on the club's official list. The list is made available online, so that aspiring members can check how many of the 325 places included they have been to.

How long do you have to be in a country so that it "counts"? The club took this into serious consideration for some time and finally decided that even the shortest visit would be accepted as part of a person's travels. For example, an airplane fuel stop or a two-hour stopover a traveler makes on the way to their final destination is considered a valid visit.

The club recommends that travelers do not use the list of places or the established short-stay allowances only for the purpose of competition. The list should inspire and motivate travelers to explore destinations that are not as popular as well-known resorts or famous cities.
