FUNCTION: TO TALK ABOUT **PAST HABITS**.

Aff. > Subject + USED TO + verb (BASE) + ...

Neg. > Subject + DIDN'T USE TO + verb (BASE) + ...

Int. > Did + Subject + USE TO + verb (BASE) + ... ?

Example:

- Before my surgery, I **used to** exercise every morning.
- You're wrong, we **didn't use to** drive to Bernal on the weekends, we **used to** drive to Amealco.
- Why **did** your mom **use** to collect French paintings?
- My sisters **used to** go to parties every weekend before the pandemic.
- Who **did** you **use to** visit before the quarantine?
