I'm a hotel receptionist. I usually work from 7 am to 3 pm but occasionally I work nights. I prefer working during the day because I meet more guests. When I'm on night shift I'm responsible for the 'close of day'. I check both the manual records and the computer records to see which rooms are occupied, which are unoccupied, which are closed for maintenance and which need cleaning. The manager is not on duty at night or at the weekends so I'm responsible for everything at these times.

During the day shift I send faxes and emails confirming bookings, check in new guests and prepare bills for the guests checking out. I also answer the telephone calls, deal with enquiries, take reservations and put calls through to other departments.

Before a large group checks in, we receive a running list of all the names from the booking agents. I check people in as fast as possible because they have usually traveled a long way and I know they are tired. After that I check the running list against the names of guests who checked in. There are often differences so I phone the agency to confirm the group names.
