## Present Simple – Revision of Affirmative Sentences

## Read and learn:

To talk about our habits or routine, we use  
the **VERB FORMS** of the **Present Simple**.

In an affirmative sentence:

When the **person** is **He, She** or **It**, the **verb** needs **S** or **ES** at the end.

For the **other persons**, the **verb** does **NOT** need **S** or **ES**.

**3)** Look at the table and the speech bubble:

What do you see in the verb "listen" and in the verb "go" for the different persons?

### Grammar Present Simple affirmative

| PERSON    | + VERB            |
|-----------|-------------------|
| I         | listen to music.  |
| You       | listen to music.  |
| He/She/It | listens to music. |
| We        | listen to music.  |
| You       | listen to music.  |
| They      | listen to music.  |



Can you see the letter **S** in "listens"?

Can you see the letters **ES** in "goes"?

Now, choose **YES** or **NO**:

In an **affirmative sentence**:

- We add **S** or **ES** to the verb when the person is **I, YOU, WE** or **THEY**.
- We add **S** or **ES** to the verb when the person is **HE, SHE** or **IT**.

#### 4) **LOOK!** Remember the Spelling Rules for adding S to the verb:

| Rule   | Examples   |
|--|--|
| 1) Most verbs -----> add <b>S</b>  | walk -----> walk <b>s</b><br>get -----> get <b>s</b><br>play -----> play <b>s</b>                                |
| 2) Verbs ending in the letters<br><b>o / ch / sh / x / z</b> -----> add <b>ES</b>                | go -----> go <b>es</b><br>do -----> do <b>es</b><br>watch -----> watch <b>es</b><br>brush -----> brush <b>es</b> |
| 3) Verbs ending in <b>CONSONANT + Y</b> -----> change <b>y</b> for <b>i</b><br>and add <b>ES</b> | study -----> stud <b>ies</b><br>tidy -----> tid <b>ies</b>   |
