To talk about our habits or routine, we use
the VERB FORMS of the Present Simple.

In an affirmative sentence:

- When the **person** is **He, She or It**, the **verb** needs **S** or **ES** at the end.
- For the **other persons**, the **verb** does **NOT** need **S** or **ES**.

PERSON	+	VERB
I		listen to music.
You		listen to music.
He/She/It		listens to music.
We		listen to music.
You		listen to music.
They		listen to music.

Can you see the letters **ES** in "goes"?

Now, choose YES or NO:

In an affirmative sentence:

- We add **S** or **ES** to the verb when the person is **I, YOU, WE** or **THEY**.
- We add **S** or **ES** to the verb when the person is **HE, SHE** or **IT**.

4) **LOOK!**

Remember the Spelling Rules for adding S to the verb:

Rule	Examples
1) Most verbs -----> add S	walk -----> walks get -----> getS play -----> playS
2) Verbs ending in the letters o / ch / sh / x / z -----> add ES	go -----> goes do -----> does watch -----> watches brush -----> brushes
3) Verbs ending in CONSONANT + Y ----> change y for i and add ES	study -----> studies tidy -----> tidies



