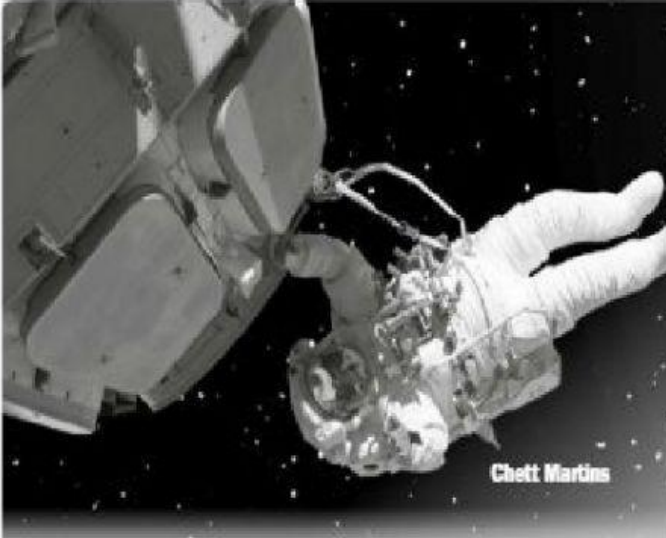

What's a typical day like in space? We spoke to astronaut Chett Martins to find out.

CM: Do I have a daily routine? The answer is 'yes' – routine is important up here. It doesn't matter where we are, we always get up at the same time. The clocks here show the time back in Houston, Texas. The first thing we do is wash. We don't have a shower, but it is important to stay clean, so we use liquid soap, water and a towel. After that, we have breakfast, then call mission control to talk about the plans for the rest of the day. We are always busy as there are lots of jobs to do. We usually work for 12 hours a day, so our days are quite long.

After we finish work for the morning, we have lunch. In the past, food in space was terrible. Everything came in a tube and tasted disgusting! However, things have changed. Now we eat a lot of the same food we did back on Earth – fruit, vegetables, meat ... However, most food is dried so you have to add water. We eat three meals a day and even have snacks like nuts and chocolate. After lunch, we spend a lot of time doing boring jobs like cleaning or making repairs to the equipment. It's also really important to exercise and most astronauts spend two hours a day running or cycling on special machines. I like to exercise in the afternoon after lunch.

That's it really. I love my job and I feel lucky to be one of a small group of people to do such an amazing job. After all, the view is out of this world!
