

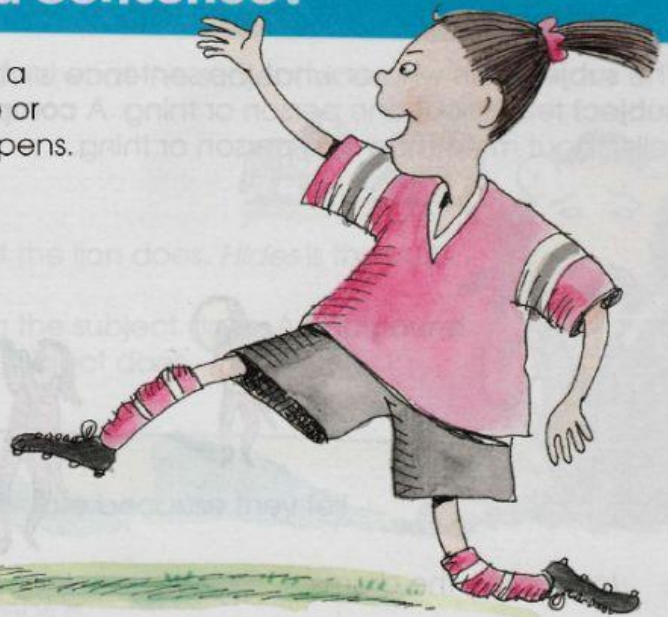
# What Is a Sentence?

A **sentence** is a group of words that tells a complete thought. A sentence tells who or what is doing something and what happens.



kicks the ball (fragment)

This is not a sentence. This group of words does not tell who is doing something.



Josie kicks the ball. (sentence)

This is a sentence. It tells who is doing something and what she is doing.

Select s if the group of words is a sentence. Or, select f if the group of words is a fragment.
