### Present Simple



### Present Continuous



**S + verb**

**S + am/is/are (not) + V-ing**

**Express general truths**

E.g: It rarely rains in the desert.

**Describe actions happening now**

E.g: She is reading a newspaper upstairs.

**Indicate present habits**

E.g: The birds return to the island every morning.

**Express annoying habits (+ always)**

E.g: You're always forgetting to pay the bills.

**Express timetable events**

E.g: The plane to London takes off at 6:30 a.m.

**Describe future arrangements**

E.g: She's getting married on 3 November.

**Indicate permanent states**

E.g: I like the new James Bond film.

**Express temporary states**

E.g: She's working at the museum until the end of this month.
