Calendars and Clocks

Calendars and **clocks** help us measure time. **Calendars** tell us the **date**. **Clocks** tell us the **time of day**. We use calendars to remember important days and appointments.

Calendars tell us the month, day, and year.

There are **7 days** in a **week**.

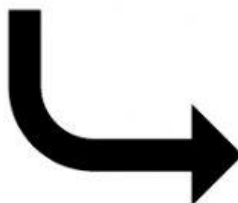
There are **4 to 5 weeks** in a month.

There are **12 months** in a year.
