Types of Sentences

There are four types of sentences: declarative, interrogative, imperative, and exclamatory.

Declarative sentences make a statement and ends in a full stop (.).

Example: Balfour Consumer's is having a 20% sale.

Interrogative sentences ask a question and end in a question mark (?).

Example: What school do you attend?

Imperative sentences make a command or gives a request and ends in a full stop (.).

Example: Cynthia, go wash the dishes.

Exclamatory sentences make a statement with expression and ends with an exclamation mark (!).

Example: Wow, that mountain is huge!
