IDU: Vertebrates

Vertebrates are animals that have a backbone. Another name for backbone is **spine**.

Vertebrates are broken up into five groups: **mammals, fish birds, amphibians, and reptiles.**

Mammals are warm-blooded vertebrates that has hair and fur.

Fish are cold-blooded vertebrates with gills and fins, living in the water.

Birds are warm-blooded vertebrates with feathers, wings, a beak, and typically by being able to fly. They lay eggs.

Amphibians are cold-blooded vertebrates consists of the frogs, toads, newts, salamanders, etc.

Reptiles a vertebrate animal with dry scaly skins that lay soft-shell eggs on land.

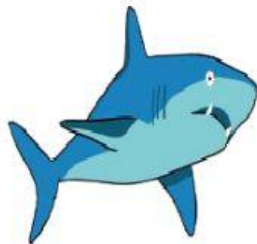
