(1815-1852)



As a young **child**, Ada Lovelace was very good at **Maths and Languages** (English and French). She didn't go to university, but she studied Maths with a professor from **the University of London**. In the 1840s, she **designed a language** for the world's first computer. In 1835, Ada **married William King**. They **had two sons and a daughter**.

**Shusaku
Arakawa**
(1936-2010)



Shusaku Arakawa was an **abstract painter**. He also **designed houses and apartment buildings**.

Shusaku was born in Japan in 1936. He moved to the USA in 1961 and he married **Madeline Gins**, another artist. In 1998, Shusaku won a competition for **designing buildings**.

He died in **the USA** in 2010.

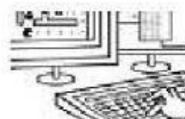
