





Location of the Northern Mountains and the Northern Plains

The Greater Himalayas

The Greater Himalayas are the northernmost and the highest of all the Himalayan ranges. The average height of this range is about 6,000 m. The world's highest peak, **Mt Everest** lies here. Kanchenjunga, Nanga Parbat, and Nanda Devi are some of the highest peaks of this range. The range also has many mountain passes. A route through a mountain is called a

mountain pass. Some important Himalayan passes are Zoji La, Jelep La, Shipki La, and Nathu La.
