- ☐ Verbs with Direct Objects are called Transitive verbs.
- ☐ The action is in “transit” from the subject to the direct object.
- ☐ Example:
  - Bob eats a burger.
  - Bob shoots Steven.
  - Bob gives Steven a cookie.
- ☐ All sentences lacking direct objects are intransitive.
- ☐ This means all linking verb sentences are intransitive.
