Transitive or Intransitive Verbs

- Verbs with Direct Objects are called Transitive verbs.
- The action is in “transit” from the subject to the direct object.
- Example:

Bob **eats** a **burger**.

Bob **shoots** Steven.

Bob **gives** Steven a **cookie**.

- All sentences lacking **direct objects** are intransitive.
- This means all linking verb sentences are intransitive.
