Jam and Toast Recipe

Ingredients: bread, butter, jam

Equipment: toaster, knife

Directions:

First, wash your hands.

After that, spread the butter on the toast with the knife.

Then, spread the jam on the toast with the knife.

Next, cut the toast into two pieces with the knife.

Finally, put the two pieces of toast together.
