Downloading, Installing and Opening Pencil

Pencil is a free application that can be downloaded from the Internet. Pencil is an animation application that was made by volunteers. To download Pencil, go to website 'www.pencil-animation.org' and then click '**Download**'. Then, choose the Pencil application for the Microsoft Windows operating system '**Pencil v0.4.4b**'. After that, choose a location for the application and then click '**Save**'. Click on '**Allow**' to install the application. If you do not know the application name or publisher, always choose 'Don't Allow'. To open Pencil, go to Start menu and click on Pencil. You can create a shortcut for Pencil by dragging it from the Start menu to your desktop. When the application opens, a blank Pencil window will be displayed.
