Emmeline Pankhurst

She was an important figure in the Suffragette movement, that is to say a British suffragist- What does this mean? She wanted women in England to vote so she worked hard for this. Why? Because up to that moment only men could vote. She lived between 1858 and 1928 and married Richard Marsden Pankhurst. She had a daughter. Her daughter was also a suffragist. With the Representation of the People's Act of 1928 women could finally vote. This law was passed a few weeks after Emmeline died. Pankhurst's autobiography *My Own Story*, appeared in 1914.
