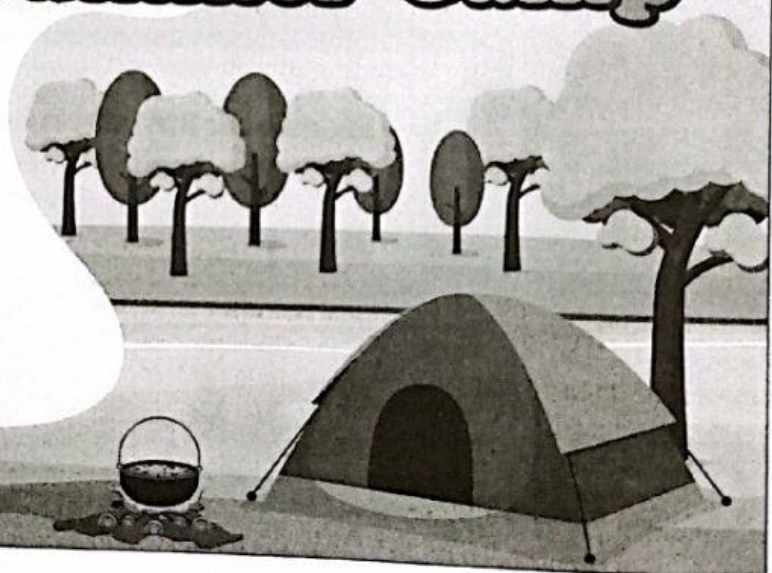

### Part 3

#### Penang Digital Library

The Penang Digital Library is a collaborative project between the Penang State Government, Eastern & Oriental Berhad (E&O) and Keysight Technologies supported by TIME. The library aims to redesign how information is spread and used in today's world and at the same time to put in the human touch in the aspect of social collaboration. In short, the library's objective is to provide a peaceful and encouraging space for digital learning and to inspire interaction within the community.

The digital library is opened for 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and proven to be suitable to night owls and students who burn the midnight oil during exam seasons. Launched in October 2016, phase one of the library building saw 3 848 members accessing 3 024 e-books. RM2.5 million phase one digital library is located at the premises of the former Puspanita building that is situated within the compound of Penang Free School. Inspired by a similar project by Keysight Technologies for the Penang Science Café, the Penang Digital Library is set to be the next evolution of libraries. Phase one library is built to accommodate 140 visitors at a time.

Penang Digital Library has then been expanded when greater demands call for it. Spending over RM10.8 million for Penang Digital Library phase two, it offers over 3 000 e-books, e-magazines and reference journals for its users. Phase two, launched in February 2019, is composed of two double-storey buildings which house a comfortable reading space at Mansion Library, learning and discussion space as well as children area, dining space and a café in the park. Phase two has been expanded to accommodate up to 500 visitors at a time with a total area of 16 000 square feet. Chief Minister Chow Kon Yeow mentioned that the opening of the second phase was in line with the state's Penang 2030 vision plan to transform Penang into a model city which aims on becoming a family-focused, green and smart state.
