Exercise 2: Fill the gaps with the simple past to complete the story about Snow White.

Snow White was the daughter of a beautiful queen, who died when the girl **(be)** young. Her father **(marry)** again, but the girl's stepmother was very jealous of her because she was so beautiful.

The evil queen **(order)** a hunter to kill Snow White but he couldn't do it because she was so lovely. He **(chase)** her away instead, and she **(take)** *refuge* with seven dwarfs *in* their house in the forest. She **(live)** with the dwarfs and took care of them and they **(love)** her dearly.

- **dwarf** (n): người lùn
- **take refuge in** something or someplace: dùng nơi nào/cái gì để trú ẩn

Then one day the talking mirror **(tell)** the evil queen that Snow White was still alive. She **(change)** herself into a witch and **(make)** a **poisoned** apple. She **(go)** to the dwarfs' house **disguised as** an old woman and **tempted** Snow White **to** eat the poisoned apple, which **(put)** her into an **everlasting** sleep.

- **poisoned** (a): được tẩm độc
- **disguise** someone **as**: hóa trang cho ai đó thành gì đó
- **tempt** someone **to** do something: dụ dỗ ai đó làm gì đó
- **everlasting** (a): vĩnh viễn

Finally, a prince **(find)** her in the glass **coffin** where the dwarfs had put her and woke her up with a kiss. Snow White and the prince **(be)** married and lived happily ever after.

- **coffin** (n): quan tài
