

Comparative Adjectives (Perbandingan)

We use comparative adjectives to compare two nouns (objects, people and place).

Usually, comparative adjectives are added '-er' at the end of the adjective. Some adjectives uses 'more ___ than' or 'less ___ than'

When comparing, we need to use word 'than' after the adjectives.

Remember! Use comparative adjective to compare TWO NOUNS.

Add '-er'

cats are smaller than dogs.

cars are faster than bicycle.

'more' or 'less'

I have less money than my friend.

This drawing is more beautiful than the other.

More examples!



Ameerah is taller than Liza.

Liza is shorter than Ameerah.

Syahmi runs faster than Alif.

Alif runs slower than Syahmi.
