Spelling: Words with Hard and Soft c and g

The letter **c** can spell the hard sound heard at the beginning of cow. It can also spell the soft sound heard at the beginning of cent. The letter **g** can spell the hard sound in garden or the soft sound in danger. When the letter c or g is followed by **e**, **i**, or **y**, the c or g usually has a soft sound. When the c or g is followed by vowels **a**, **o**, or **u**, it has a hard sound.
