## **Simple Subjects and Simple Predicates**

The **simple subject** is the part of the sentence that tells who or what the sentence is all about.

The **simple predicate** is the part of the sentence that tells what the subject is doing or what it is.

**For example:** *Bobby hugs the dog.*

*Bobby (simple subject)    hugs (simple predicate)*
