Son Doong Cave is (23) _____ in the Phong Nha-Ke Bang National Park, which was designated a Unesco World Heritage Site in 2003. Not only is the park home to the world's largest cave, but it actually has hundreds of cave systems as well.

Only one tour operator has the (24) _____ to bring travellers on the trek into the cave, and tickets for 2017 expeditions went on sale this week and, according to the tour company, Oxalis Adventure Tours sold (25) _____ in the first 20 hours.

Oxalis Adventure Tours has noted that the company may only organise tours for 500 to 600 people during the January to August season. The tickets are sold to the first applicants who meet all of the health requirements, as the six-day trips require travellers to be able to trek about 50 kilometres, and navigate through the caves. Unlike the life in the countryside, which is often considered to be simple and traditional, the life in cities is modern and complicated. People, from different regions, move to cities to seek a better life for themselves and their children. The inhabitants in cities work as secretaries, businessmen, teachers, government officials, factory workers and even street vendors or construction workers.

The high cost of living requires city dwellers, especially those with low incomes, to work harder or to take part-time jobs. For many people, an ordinary day starts as usual by getting up in the early morning to do exercise in public parks, then they prepare for a full day of work and study, then travel along crowded boulevards or narrow streets filled with motorists and return home after a busy day. They usually live in large houses, or high-rise apartment blocks or even in small rented rooms equipped with modern facilities, like the Internet, telephone, television, and so on. Industrialization and modernization as well as globalization have big **impacts** on the lifestyle in the cities. The most noticeable impact is the Western style of clothes. The "ao dai" – Vietnamese traditional dresses are no longer regularly worn by Vietnamese women in their daily life. Instead, jeans, T-shirts and fashionable clothes are widely preferred.
