#### Prepositions of time

- **at** six o'clock / midday / two o'clock  
*I get up **at** seven o'clock.*
- **in** the morning/afternoon/evening/night  
*You go home **in** the evening.*
- **on** Sunday/Sundays, Wednesday/Wednesdays  
*We don't work **on** Fridays and Saturdays.*
- **at** night  
*They sleep **at** night.*
