

Regular and Irregular Plural Nouns



Watch the Plural Nouns video so you are ready for class!

Remember that **nouns** are words that name people, places, things, or animals. A noun is **singular** if there is one. A noun is **plural** if there are two or more.

Usually, we just add an **-s** to the end of the word to show that it is plural. Some words already end in the **S** sound or a similar sound. For those words, we add **-es**. Some words that end in **o** also use **-es**. If a word ends in **y**, we often drop the **y** and add **-ies**.

singular	plural
card	cards
princess	princesses
potato	potatoes
candy	candies



Change the sentences below. If the sentence uses a plural noun, change the number to one and make the noun singular. If the sentence uses a singular noun, increase the number and make the noun plural.

Some nouns are **irregular**. This means they have their own rules.

ox	oxen
child	children
tooth	teeth
foot	feet
man	men
woman	women
mouse	mice

For nouns that end in **y**, many plural forms end in **-ies** (e.g., baby - babies). If there is a vowel before the **y**, just put an **-s** at the end (e.g., monkey - monkeys). Only a few nouns ending in **o** end in **-es**. The most common ones are **potatoes**, **heroes**, **echoes**, and **vetoos**.
