An ancient temple has been found in Italy

A group of builders have found an ancient temple in the Italian city of Naples. It's the second time a temple has been found in that part of the country. The builders were drilling into the ground to build a new lift for an underground car park. When the builders started seeing what looked like an ancient structure, they stopped drilling and called a group of scientists to come and investigate. One of the scientists explained the investigation process, saying "We're using drills to make holes in the ground around

the area of the discovery. Then we're putting cameras in the holes which can help us measure the size and shape of the structure. It's much bigger than we first thought. It's going to be a difficult job, but we'll use our best technology and special tools to prevent doing any damage to the temple". Officials from the Italian government have said that the temple was probably built during the Roman Empire, but they aren't sure exactly how old it is yet. They think it will take about a year to uncover the whole temple.
