



TYPES OF SENTENCES

The four types of sentences are **declarative**, **interrogative**, **imperative** & **exclamatory**.

declarative

A **declarative** sentence makes a statement or tells about something. It ends with a period.

e.g., The nucleus controls the activities in a cell.

Interrogative

An **interrogative** sentence asks something. It ends with a question mark.

e.g., Why does the vacuole store food, water and waste?

imperative

An **imperative** sentence gives a command or makes a request. It ends with a period.

e.g., Colour the chloroplast green.

exclamatory

An **exclamatory** sentence shows strong feeling. It ends with an exclamation mark.

e.g., What a tiny cell!
