## Affirmative

I work  
 You work  
 He works  
 She works  
 It works  
 We work  
 You work  
 They work

## Negative

I don't work  
 You don't work  
 He doesn't work  
 She doesn't work  
 It doesn't work  
 We don't work  
 You don't work  
 They don't work

## Interrogative

Do I work?  
 Do you work?  
Does he work?  
Does she work?  
Does it work?  
 Do we work?  
 Do you work?  
 Do they work?

## Short answers

Yes, I do.      No, I don't.  
 Yes, you do.      No, you don't.  
 Yes, he does.      No, he doesn't.  
 Yes, she does.      No, she doesn't.  
 Yes, it does.      No, it doesn't.  
 Yes, we do.      No, we don't.  
 Yes, you do.      No, you don't.  
 Yes, they do.      No, they don't.
