



Open and Closed Syllables

A syllable can be Open or Closed.

Open Syllable	the syllable ends with a vowel that makes a long sound
Closed Syllable	the syllable ends with a consonant, and the vowel makes a short sound

DIRECTIONS: Read each word. Separate the word into syllables with a slash mark (/). If the first syllable of the word is an open syllable, select Open and Closed Syllable. If the first syllable of the word has a closed syllable, select 2 Closed Syllables.

Example: *picnic* - pic/nic
