Homework benefits for adolescent students: surprising revelations

If you are a student, homework might be your (LITTLE) favorite task because it requires you to study off the school campus. However, sometimes it is inevitable to attempt your academic (ASSIGN) outside of school because you have to score well and maintain your overall academic (PERFORM) at school. You must have already heard most of them from your teachers because they want you to realize the (SIGNIFY) of these assignments. Here are some important benefits of home assignments that might come as a surprise to you.

Benefits you can get out of attempting home assignments

Homework...

1. *Helps the student revise the work done in class.* When students sit down to attempt their home assignments after school, they will see that there are some important things being (REPEAT). School is not a place to repeat old concepts but it is somewhere a student should learn new concepts. They can revise these concepts when they are back at home.
2. *Develops a good (RELATE) between children's parents and teachers.* It acts as a bridge between the teachers and parents because they usually do not interact on a regular basis. The parents can judge the teaching style and evaluate what the teaching policies are.
3. *Lets the parent know what the student is up to.* By looking at the kid's home assignments a parent can tell what they are studying at school. They can write notes and observe the (RESPOND) of their kids and the teachers.

4. *Helps the teachers in realizing where a student needs (ASSIST). The teacher can check the home assignments and see which areas are weak and where the students need help.*
5. *Helps students prepare for (STANDARD) tests and exams.*
6. *It is a good way to develop a sense of (RESPONSIBLE).*
