Present Simple V(+s)	He wears the dress.	Present Simple (am/is/are) + V(p.p.)	The dress is worn.
Past Simple V (2 nd form)	He wore the dress.	Past Simple (was/were) + V(p.p.)	The dress was worn.
Present Continuous (am/is/are) + v-ing	He is wearing the dress.	Present Continuous (am/is/are) + be-ing + V(p.p.)	The dress is being worn.
Past continuous (was/were) + v-ing	He was wearing the dress.	Past continuous (was/were) + be-ing + V(p.p.)	The dress was being worn.
Present Perfect (has/have) + v(p.p.)	He has worn the dress.	Present Perfect (has/have) + been + v(p.p.)	The dress has been worn.
Past Perfect (had) + v(p.p.)	He had worn the dress.	Past Perfect (had) + been + v(p.p.)	The dress had been worn.
Future (will) + v. (am/is/are) + going to + v.	He will wear the dress. He is going to wear the dress.	Future (will) + be + V(p.p.) (am/is/are) + going to + be + v(p.p.)	The dress will be worn. The dress is going to be worn.
Modals (can/may/should) + v.	He can wear the dress. He may wear the dress. He should wear the dress.	Modals (can/may/should) + be + V(p.p.)	The dress can be worn. The dress may be worn. The dress should be worn.
