Steven Spielberg

Steven Spielberg was born in Cincinnati, Ohio in 1946. His mom was a pianist and his dad was an engineer. They belonged to the Jewish community of Cincinnati. He was always dreaming of becoming a famous movie director. At the age of 13, he made his first movie called 'Escape from Nowhere'. At the age of 16, he produced his second movie called 'Firelight' which he played in the local theaters of his hometown. He was the youngest person to ever get a job as a director in a major Hollywood Studio.

His first blockbuster was 'Jaws', which received three Oscars. Most of his movies have been very successful including E.T., Close Encounters, Schindler's List, Jurassic Park and many others.

Spielberg's second great love is children. He loves them very much. He is a great dad. That is the reason why he has seven children of his own.
