Do/Don't

When the subject is a plural noun or plural pronoun (**I, You, We, They**), we must use do or don't.

Affirmative Do/Does

I **do** my homework every day.



She **does** her homework every day.

Does/Doesn't

When the subject is a singular noun or singular pronoun (**He, She, It**), we must use does or doesn't.

Negative Don't/Doesn't

We **don't** like eating vegetables.



He **doesn't** like eating vegetables.
She **doesn't** like eating vegetables.
